The Beginning: Genesis 1-3

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." (1:1)

"The darkness He called night." (1:5)

"God made the two great lights (the sun and the moon)." (1:16)

"In the day you eat thereof you shall surely die." (2:17)

Satan appears as the deceiver of mankind. (3:1)

Shown a garden, into which defilement entered. (3:6-7)

The walk of God with man is interrupted. (3:8-10)

Initial victory of the serpent. (3:13)

"I will greatly multiply your pain." (3:16)

"Cursed is the ground for your sake." (3:17)

Man's dominion is damaged in the fall of Adam. (3:17-19)

First paradise was closed. (3:23)

Access to the Tree of Life is lost in Adam. (3:24)

They were driven from God's Presence. (3:24)

The Ending: Revelation 20-22

"I saw a new heaven and a new earth." (21:1)

"There shall be no night there." (21:25)

"The city has no need of the sun or of the moon." (21:23)

"And there shall be no more death, neither sorrow." (21:4)

Satan disappears into the lake of fire forever. (20:10)

Shown a city, "There shall in no wise enter into it anything that defiles." (21:27)

The walk of God with man is resumed. (21:3)

Ultimate victory of the Lamb. (20:10; 22:3)

"Neither shall there be pain anymore." (21:4)

"There shall be no more curse." (22:3)

Man's dominion is restored, in the reign of Christ. (22:5)

New paradise is opened. (21:24-26)

Access to the Tree of Life is regained in Christ. (22:14)

We "shall see His face." (21:3; 22:4)
